Common -ar verbs also known as infinitives

Hablar

To add an ending: remove the **-ar** from the infinitive

Necesitar

This leaves the stem of the verb.

Mirar

ex: Habl Necesit Mir

-AR VERB ENDINGS

-o	-amos
-as	-áis
-a	-an

-ar endings with subjects

Yo	-o	Nosotros	-amos
Tú	-as	Vosotros	-áis
Él	-a	Ellos	-an
Ella	-a	Ellas	-an
Ud.	-a	Uds.	-an

Hablar-to talk/speak

Hablo	Hablamos
Hablas	Habláis
Habla	Hablan

When 2 verbs are directly beside each other, the second verb does NOT get conjugated

Ex: I need to talk.

Yo necesito hablar.

If you need to say no, can't, won't or didn't...put the word NO in front of the conjugated verb

Ex: I don't work.

Yo no trabajo.

Ex: She won't talk.

Ella no habla.
